Andrew joined the Winnipeg Symphony Orchestra as Assistant Principal Double Bass in 2013, after working as a freelance bassist in Chicago. He started the bass in his late teens, studying with his father Robert Goodlett. Andrew was an Emerson Scholar at Interlochen Arts Camp, going on to study at Michigan State University and Northwestern University. Andrew is a versatile musician, playing a variety of instruments and styles, with a strong interest and expertise in historical styles and instruments. Andrew has performed in many festivals in the United States and Europe, including a fellowship at the Aspen Music Festival, Music Academy of the West, the National Youth Orchestra of the Netherlands, New York String Orchestra Seminar, and the Sarasota Music Festival. As an educator Andrew helps teach his father's large studio in the summer, with an emphasis on creating well rounded young musicians. He is also currently teaching musicianship classes through DKSM in Winkler.
